Amber is a member of the Mississaugas of Rice Lake, Alderville First Nation where she has lived for nearly 30 years. She has been in the position of Executive Director of Dnaagdawenmag Binnoojiiyag Child and Family Services for the past six and a half years developing the agency's capacity to deliver services for First Nations, Métis, and Inuit.

She comes to the position with a BA in Public Administration and Governance from Ryerson University, a Juris Doctor of Laws degree from University of Toronto Faculty of Law, and a Masters of Social Work from Wilfred Laurier University.

Amber has spent most of her career working for indigenous people and communities, including eight years of law practice before joining Dnaagdawenmag Binnoojiiyag. She strongly believes in the restoration of jurisdiction to Indigenous peoples to look after their own children, while also having a strong commitment to reconciliation.
